↑ HOW TO PREPARE PAPERS FOR BRAIN MACHINE (16pts)

Abstract-In the following, how the accompanying letter and the paper itself should be prepared is explained. This document also is prepared according to the explained format. Accepted papers will be published in the proceedings as they are submitted. Selected papers will be published in International Journal of KES and ELEKTRIK after a refereeing process (11 pts italic).

1. ACCOMPANYING LETTER

In the accompanying letter, the following should be included:

- 1) The complete title of the paper, author(s), affiliation(s), mailing, email and homepage address(es)
- 2) The abstract (the same as the one included in the paper),
- 3) Keywords to be selected from the list of topics given in the call for papers,
- 4) A short resume of the authors, each being not more than 150 words,
- 5) Who will present the paper and if she/he is a student.

2. PREPARATION OF THE PAPERS (12 pts)

Papers not longer than 8 pages should be prepared on A4 size paper with one inch margins on all four sides. The first page should have a 2 inch margin at the top. Centered at the top of the first page should be the complete title of the paper, author(s), affiliation(s), mailing, email and homepage address(es) then the abstract, not to exceed 15 lines, followed by the text. The single column format text should be written in single line spacing by using a font similar to the one used in this text (Times, 11pts).

2.1. Sections, Subsections, Figures, References (12 pts)

Sections and subsections should be numbered and titled as in this text. Capital letters should be used for the section titles, and small letters for the subsections. Paragraphs should be separated by appropriate spacing. Books should have referenced as shown in [2] and the papers as in [1].

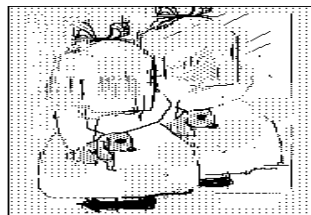


Figure 1. A centered figure (10pts)

Figures and tables should be assigned numbers, they should be referenced in the text and should be centered in the page as shown in Fig.1. (There may be more than one figure/table in the same space.)

Equations should be numbered as shown in (1)

$$x + x^2 = 1 \quad (1)$$

Do not insert page numbers in your document, they will be inserted later.

3. HOW TO SEND THE PAPERS

Send your

- 1) Accompanying letter as a **word document** or **text** file attachment
- 2) Camera ready paper as a separate **postscript** file attachment
